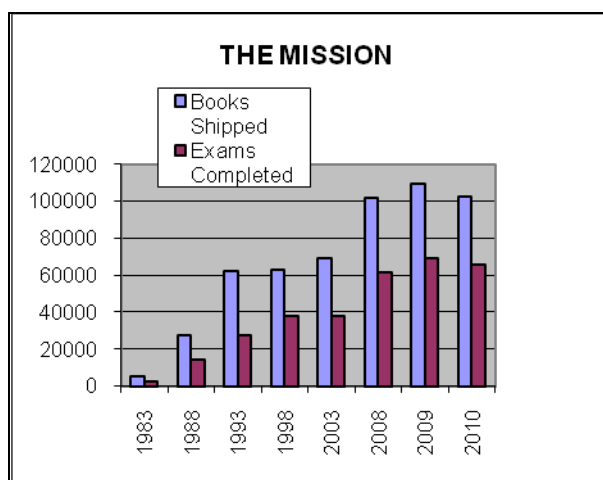


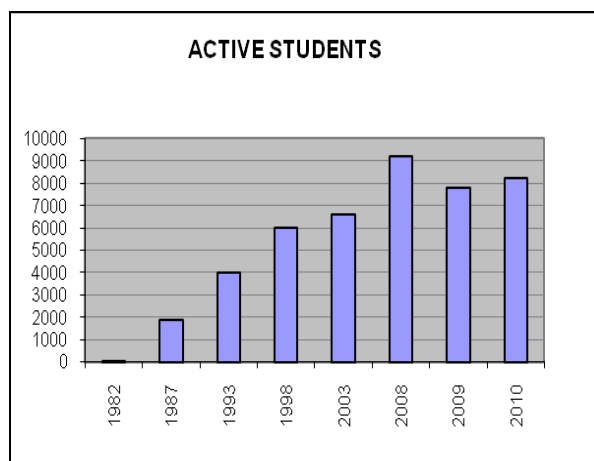


Welcome to our 2010 Year End Summary. We hope the visuals will help you track our progress and areas of need. The graphs show five year increments plus the last three years.

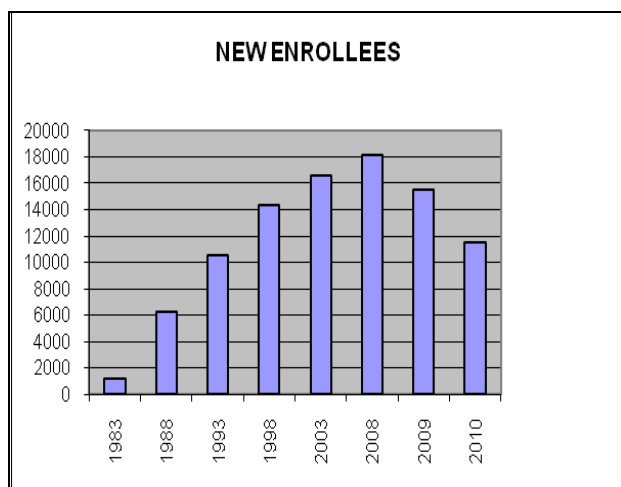
THE MISSION: To offer free Bible correspondence courses to prisoners of Texas and Louisiana. Many will meet Christ for the first time; many more will be prodigals coming home and maturing as disciples. To that end we shipped 102,384 courses in 2010 and 400 volunteers counseled on 65,526 exams.



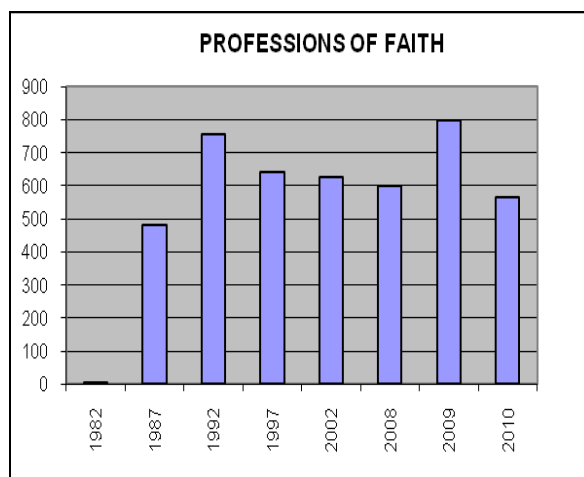
THE STUDENTS: By year's end we had climbed to 8,230 active students from an earlier low of 7,019. For those who have not returned a completed exam within 90 days, we follow up with a "You've Been Missed" postcard. Because of their circumstances, these men and women need much encouragement.

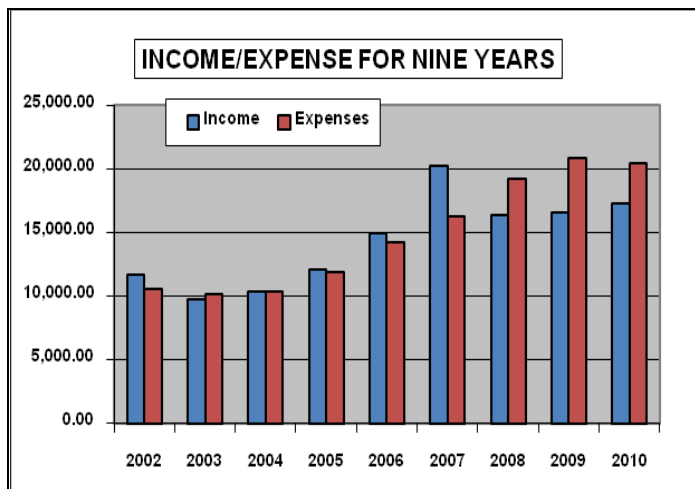


NEW ENROLLEES: Our new bright green enrollment card is our main evangelistic tool. For 2010 there were 11,487 new inmates asking for a course. Each course is mailed with an enrollment card so that the current student can be a witness to those nearby.

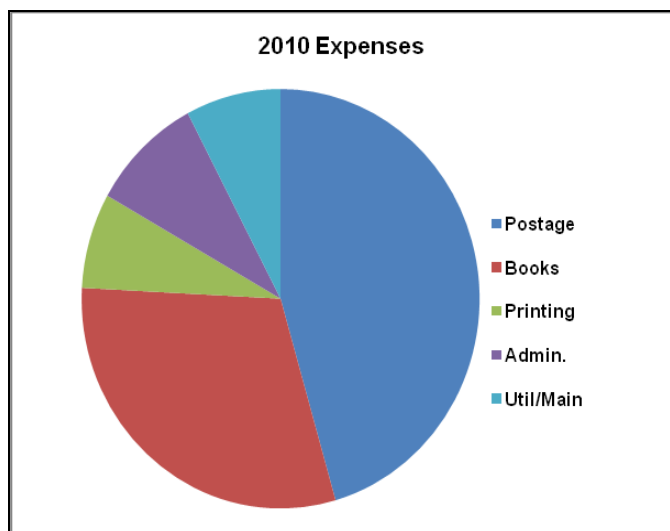


PROFESSIONS: *BORN TO WIN* is the first of five courses mailed to assess the student's spiritual status. In 2010 we obtained 567 professions of faith or an average of 47 per month. Their delightful testimonies can be read in our monthly newsletter.





INCOME/EXPENSES: Like most non-profits, our mission is totally supported by those individuals, churches, and grantors who understand God's heart of compassion and mercy. And like most faith-based organizations, we have felt the pinch over the last several years as gifts have decreased. For 2010 our average monthly support is about \$3,200 short of the costs to maintain our program.



Postage (45.53%), Books (30.29%) and Printing (7.33%) account for 83% of our budget. Printing includes all our envelopes, forms, letters, and the monthly newsletters. Several years ago cost-cutting measure were implemented, but they also affected our outreach. We don't want to diminish our mission, as long as inmates are requesting help.

Therefore, this year we will be promoting several Project Funding to aid meeting our goals. Your participation with us is greatly needed as we near night "when no one can work." John 9:4

WPM does not offer courses beyond 58 units, but at its discretion, Emmaus Correspondence School may allow the student to continue up to 108 units. This plan gives the student incentive to keep on with the studies. Our graduates stand as a tribute to the more than 400 counselors who give of their time and talents to encourage students and to edify them in Christ. They are also a tribute to those who spend long hours without pay: some ministering in a business way, some donating needed goods, some giving financially, and some upholding WPM in prayer. We praise God for this high-water mark in an inmate's rehabilitation.

"SINCE I'VE TRUSTED CHRIST..."

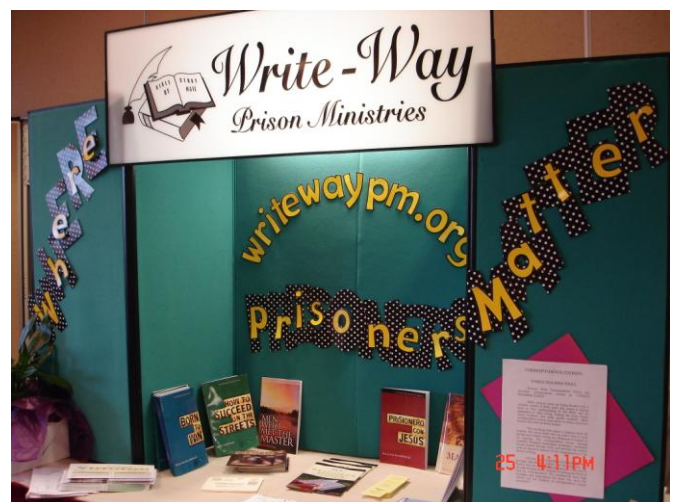

The following excerpt from F.W. Krummacher's THE SUFFERING SAVIOR was first written in 1854 and published by Moody Press in 1947. Pass slowly over the language and let this meditation fill your heart with gratitude for our Savior's sacrifice. And ask the Lord to give our students understanding also as they study His Word.

UP TO JERUSALEM



"Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be accomplished... but they [the 12] understood none of these things;" Luke 18:31,34 NKJ

"Who can resist inquiring what it was they did not understand? Is it not obvious that the Evangelist's meaning is that he who would only apprehend the history of Christ's sufferings, and regard His passion as a martyrdom, not essentially different from the bloody testimony borne by other saints, does not understand its true signification?

"We sinned, and were exposed to the curse.

"The Word that was with God, and was God, then was made flesh.

"The eternal Son became our brother;

"Took upon Himself our sin, in the way of a mysterious imputation.

"Paid our debt to the majesty of the inviolable law;

"Covered our nakedness with His righteousness;

"Presented us, as those in whose stead He appeared, unblamable and acceptable to the Father;

"Excited the hallelujahs of angels at our exaltation;

"Elevated us to a participation of His riches, blessedness, and privileges;

"Pitched tents of peace for us around the throne of God;

"And connected us with Himself by the bond of eternal gratitude and affection.

"Such is the edifice which the Almighty reared upon the ruin of sin; and of which the disciples, at that time, had not the remotest idea."

And my brothers, you who were already Christians, prayed with me and I asked the Lord to enter my heart and told him I wanted to serve him forever.

"And now it seems that everything is turning out well for me. I do my study with you and it seems that I will soon have the opportunity to be free. And even though I know I am sick, I feel healthy and happy because now Christ lives in me. I am not afraid of death because I know all this is temporary and I will be with Christ forever." **Eulalio**

NUMBERS.....

In preparing to write grant applications I compiled some data for the last ten years. The Lord has so blessed WPM!

- * The number of students reaching 48 units per year has gone from 48 (2001) to 287 (2010).
- * During those ten years we enrolled an average of 17,358 new students each year or about 1,447 per month.
- * During those ten years we received an average of 579 professions each year or about 48 per month.
- * In 2001 we mailed 74,315 courses; in 2010 we mailed 102,384 courses, an increase of 38%.
- * In 2001 we graded and counseled 40,882 exams; in 2010 we worked on 65,526 exams, an increase of 60%.
- * Cost of courses and postage has gone from 61% (2001) to 72% (2010) of our total expenses.

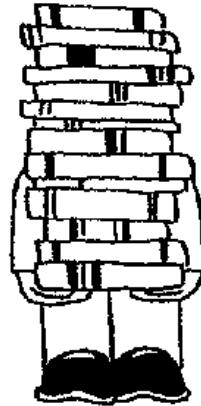

VICTIMS

In our ardor to serve the incarcerated, we may forget there are victims behind the scene. They may or may not have had their day in court. They most likely were not compensated. If an inmate feels anguish, anxiety, and hurt as prison time becomes a reality, then you can be sure the victim is equally feeling pain, perhaps more so. Is anyone serving them?

Many parolees pay a monthly fee into a fund for reimbursing victims as the court sees fit. But some losses cannot be compensated. A spouse or parent may be a victim and may lose a home, a job, an automobile. Children of the incarcerated suffer the most. They often do not understand the complexities of the law and punishment. One source says that children of inmates have a 70% chance of ending up in prison. Is anyone serving them?

PAY IT FORWARD

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Rom. 5:8

A few years ago the movie, "Pay It Forward," became popular with its emphasis on good works. The social studies teacher challenged his students to think of a way to change the world and then put it into practice. One of the young boys came up with "Pay it forward," doing something for somebody that they can't do for themselves. Do it three times, and then those you help should do it three times, that is, "Pay it forward."

Write-Way is a gigantic "Pay it forward" ministry. We send free Bible courses to those who cannot pay us back. We pay all the postage because they cannot. We have an all volunteer team that labors on pure devotion. In an exercise of faith, they "Pay it forward."

"Your service is a gift from God leading us to salvation through repentance. Please keep up your work. It is helping save lives!" Clifton

Included in this issue we recognize all those who have excelled in their studies. The first large certificate issued by Emmaus Correspondence School (ECS) is for 36 units of work. Another is issued for 48 units, previously our "graduate" level. Completion of our curriculum is now at about 65 units and is the benchmark before "graduating" the student to ECS for more studies.

Testimonies from Ronnie and David follow and, as advanced students, they will soon graduate. Most advanced students have studied with us for 5 or more years! In 2001 48 prisoners completed our program; in 2010 287 worked their way through 48 units. With half of 2011 behind us, we already have 201 students passing the 48 unit standard and 58 completing the entire curriculum!

"Write-Way Prison Ministries – you have done it again. Every chapter of Minor Prophets was more inspiring than the previous one!" Ronnie (student since Dec 2007)

"This was another struggle lesson [Life and Prophecies of Daniel], another test for my spiritual side. You have been a blessing, a counselor I truly appreciate, for all the comments and guidance you have given me. The truth is you

kept me going. At times I wanted to give up. When I finish my time, I may have no one or nowhere to go, but where ever my destiny is, I'll have Jesus with me. When I leave I won't walk out alone. PTL!" David (4 books to graduate)

May we suggest some new ways that you can "Pay it forward?" Our numbers over the last several years tell us that it costs about \$3.55 per course to serve a student. For \$35.50 you can start ten prisoners on the road to spiritual maturity. Or \$71.00 would support twenty new students. Perhaps you can carry a prisoner through to graduation for \$213.00?

Another way you as an individual can help provide financial support for WWPM is through the Kroger Neighbor to Neighbor Donation Program. Take the enclosed letter on your next trip to Kroger and they will scan the WPM code onto your Kroger Plus Shopper's Card. A percentage of your purchase will be sent to WPM on a quarterly basis. This program has supplied about \$700 per year toward our mission. Ask other members in your family or friends to become involved in the program for greater support.

The economy is still limping along. The debt-ceiling debate has captured our attention and ignited many fears. And the Middle East "Arabic Spring" is sending uncertain signals. But for those of us "created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them," it is time for a fervent "Pay it forward" burst of energy. This will truly exalt our Lord Jesus.

We greatly appreciate the dedicated faithful individuals who comprise 74% of our donors supporting our mission of reaching prisoners in Texas and Louisiana for Christ. We are working to increase the 8% from corporate grants and business gifts. However, we recognize that this is a very competitive area and that many businesses will not consider faith-based programs. Support from churches provides about 16% of our donations. Is Write-Way a part of your church's mission program? If not, please contact us about that option so we can pursue it together.

Customer Letter



Step One:

Read through this letter to understand the advantage of being a part of the Kroger Neighbor to Neighbor Donation Program.

"I PRESS ON..."

Beyond the number of professions we publish are myriads of other students who, like Paul, confess, *"Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on...that I may lay hold...I do not count myself to have apprehended...reaching forward...I press toward the goal..."* (Phil 3:12,13,14) Like many of us, one bad choice, a day of frustration, or a period of depression may cause an inmate to consider giving up or feeling that they are not born again. We must remind them, and ourselves, that this is a pilgrimage and a process. Often it is two steps forward and one step backward (For many prisoners it may be one step forward and two steps backward!).

For this reason, we emphasize encouragement and compassion in our counseling comments on exams. A timely commendation or an appropriate Scripture verse can be that needful thing to press them toward the goal. Just recently the Lord gave me this verse to share with an inmate who had lost all hope: *"Paul... in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began..."* (Titus 1:2)

That is powerful and it encouraged me greatly! And it gave hope to this offender, incarcerated for 23 long years. My prayer is that you too will be encouraged in your daily walk, your prayers, and your faith giving. Thank you for making the pilgrimage with us.
