#### Questions 1 – Name and describe 2 ways in which the Holy Spirit ministers to unbelievers (sinners).

#### **1 - POSSIBLE ANSWERS**

The Holy Spirit **reproves** the world of sin. He convicts unbelievers of <u>righteousness</u> by pointing them to the cross, calls them to <u>repentance</u>, and makes them aware <u>judgement</u>. The Spirit also **regenerates** the person who repents and exercises faith. The Spirit **restrains** evil in the world, the work of Satan in the world, and apostasy in the church from expressing their effects to the fullest extent

#### Questions 2 - How is baptism of the Spirit different than be filled with the Spirit?

#### 2 - POSSIBLE ANSWERS

The baptism of the Spirit is a new thing in the New Testament enacted by Jesus. It is a once for all-time act that takes place in every believer at the time of conversion. It is a *relational* act that unifies us with Christ in His death, burial and resurrection and unifies with the entire church. The filling of the Spirit is evidenced in both the Old Testament and the New Testament. It is a repeatable experience of the Spirit in the life of a Christian that empowers them to serve and act in ways that are abnormal to what they would do and say.
