I've been shot in the face at the age of 7 years old, ran over at the age of 15 years old, stabbed three times at the age of 26, and ran over once more at the age of 27. And not once have I ever had a broken bone in my body because God has been by my side, even when I thought he wasn't. I want to start my own ministry someday. Can you recommend me for a faith-based halfway house in Dallas or Ft Worth?" *Victor* * *

"I am in the county jail, but by the time I get a response from you I will be back home. Eight years ago, my 22-year-old daughter passed away. I found her in the bathtub. I have never been a religious person, as I found most churches are run by hypocrites, preaching against wrongs on Sunday, but committing the wrongs on Saturday. When my daughter died, I became very angry at God.

"Through reckless decisions, I ended up in jail where I met very faithful people and started faithbased classes and Bible studies. One person could see my pain and anger. She suggested that I write you so I can continue my studies at home. She has been so supportive, helping me to open the Bible again. Thank you for reading this." *Maria* *
