On Saturday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, Write-Way marked 30 years by celebrating as a new member of the Urban Ministries Department of Park Cities Presbyterian Church in Dallas. Morning sessions were held at PCPC along with five other prison ministries. Helen May Nichols, the coordinator for WPM, has been working to establish a new Branch 076 of volunteers at her home church.

WPM serves a huge prison population of more than 325,200 in Texas and Louisiana, and yet our average active student count last year was 7,100. That is 2.15% of inmates. We are in an effort to raise that outreach to 9,000 students in five years. Will you join us in prayer to the Lord of the Harvest that He would be pleased to draw these dear men and women to Himself?

I am compelled by Hebrews 10:19-25, especially the phrase, "so much the more as you see the Day approaching." Can you see that Day approaching? Then we need to enter boldly, draw near, hold fast, stir up love, assemble together, and exhort one another. We are here for such a time as this. Let us labor together.
