I Was Beyond Lost

"I was beyond lost. I was more than a non-believer. I was an atheist. I believed you lived, you died, and the worms ate you. I was an alcoholic who spent 17 years in the U.S. Army with five tours of combat – 3 to Iraq and two to Afghanistan. I was reprogrammed not to fear death, and I suppose I didn't. I looked death in the face every day. Never thought twice about what happens after you die until...

"I had been_brought to Dallas CJ. After 40 years of never being in trouble, I was now facing a lot of time. As a retired veteran and successful business owner, I was now at 'rock bottom.' I had never been 'not in control' of my life.

"My first cellie in jail was a murderer who was on his way home. He had been locked up 25 years on a life sentence. While he was in prison, he became an ordained minister. It was this man who took me through the Bible and answered all of my questions. He led me to Jesus Christ in a jail cell.

"I went on to another unit and continued studying the Word of God. I later began a daily Bible study with some other inmates and actually taught every day for an hour for over eight months. I am in a Faith-based Dorm and am teaching and preaching. I am also going to college for my bachelor's degree in pastoral ministry. God is so good. His love endures forever!"
