These 2 additional questions, not found in the exam booklet are designed to make the student dig into the Biblical text and show they understand the Biblical principles studied throughout the course.

Questions 1 - How does the gospel deal with guilt?

2 - POSSIBLE ANSWERS

First, we need to know that a Christian has 2 natures: the old, evil, corrupt nature inherited from Adam and a new, holy and pure nature given to us by the Spirit when we believed in Christ. These 2 natures exist within a believer and are in constant conflict as long as we live in this flesh. Every Christian will commit sin during their normal Christian life, but they are not **controlled** by sin and sin is not the dominant habit. God has given us the Holy Spirit who will empower us resist temptation if we ask Him. But we are responsible for sin, it is not to be blamed on our old nature because God have provided the Spirit to give us power over our sin. When we, as Christians do sin, we do not lose our salvation, but our fellowship with God is broken.
