These 2 additional questions, not found in the exam booklet are designed to make the student dig into the Biblical text and show they understand the Biblical principles studied throughout the course.

Questions 1 - Why is it important to settle up after you have been released?

1 - POSSIBLE ANSWERS

We have biblical examples of people who have stolen making restitution for their thefts (Luke 19:1-10; Exodus 22:1-17). God wants us to "make it right" with those we have wronged and time serviced in prison may pay my debt to society but it does not reconcile things with the person(s) wronged. In Ephesians 4:28, Paul calls thieves not only to stop stealing but to go to the opposite extent and work in order to have something to give to others. Jesus tells us to **first** go and be reconciled with a person we've offended before we worship God. It may be as simple as an apology, but whatever it takes to make it right, we need to be willing to do.
