EXAM 1 – Study John 1:11-13. Have you been born again? Give reasons for your answer.

1 - VERSES

- <u>John 1:11-13</u> As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.
- <u>John 3:1-8</u> Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- <u>1 Peter 1:23</u> Having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever

EXAM 2 – State in your own words how a person can be "born from above."

2 - VERSES

- Eph. 2:8-9 By grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.
- 1 John 5:4-5 Whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world --- our faith. Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- <u>Titus 3:5</u> Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit.

- <u>John 6:68</u> Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.

• <u>John 7:38</u> He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.

- <u>Isa. 55:11</u> So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.
- Ps. 12:6 The words of the LORD are pure words, Like silver tried in a furnace of earth, Purified seven times.
- Heb. 4:12 The word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword
- <u>John 1:1</u> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

- 1 John 5:12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
- <u>Col. 2:6-7</u> As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him.

- <u>Isa. 9:6</u> For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; ...And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- <u>John 1:1</u> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- <u>John 10:28-30</u> I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand...I and My Father are one.
- <u>Heb. 1:8</u> But to the Son He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom.
- 1 John 5:20 We know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.

- Matt. 10:39 He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.

- <u>John 12:25</u> He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
- Gal. 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
- Philippians 3:8 Compared to the excellency of the knowledge of Christ, all is rubbish.

9 - VERSES

- Rom. 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- Gal. 5:16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.
- Eph. 1:13-14 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.
- 1 John 2:27 The anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
- Rom. 8:14 As many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.
- <u>1 Cor. 12:3</u> I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus accursed, and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit.
- John 16:13-14 When He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

- <u>John 17</u> Jesus Prays for Himself, for His Disciples, for All Believers.
- Ps. 145:18 Call on the Lord.
- <u>John 10:28-30</u> I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. I and My Father are one.

EXAM 11 – What is your personal reaction to Christ's trial and death?

11 - VERSES

- <u>John 10:17-18</u> My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father.
- Rom. 5:8-9 God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
- <u>1 Peter 2:21-23</u> To this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: "Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth"; who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously.
- <u>Heb. 5:8-9</u> Though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him.

- Rom. 14:11-12 As I live, says the LORD, every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to God. So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.
- <u>John 15:10</u> If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.
- 1 John 1:3-7 That which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ...But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
- Ps. 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- Nahum 1:7 The LORD is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; and He knows those who trust in Him.
