CHAPTER ONE - "ASSURANCE OF SALVATION"

1 John 5:11-12 And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. {12} He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

5. John 20:31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

6. John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

7. Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

8. Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.

9. Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, {9} not of works, lest anyone should boast.

10. 1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,

11. John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

12. John 5:24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.

13. John 10:27-29 "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. {28} "And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. {29} "My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

14. 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

1. John 16:24 "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

3. Matthew 7:7 through Matthew 7:8 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 8For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

4. Matthew 6:7 And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.

5(1). John 15:7 "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

5(2). 1 John 5:14-15 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. {15} And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

5(3) Matthew 21:22 And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."

6(1). Psalms 66:18 If I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear.

(2). Matthew 6:14 through Matthew 6:15 "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

(3). James 1:6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

(4). James 4:3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures.

(5). 1 John 3:22 And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.

7(1). Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

(2). Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, 8. Matthew 7:9-11 "Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? {10} "Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? {11} "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

9. Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; {7} and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

10. Philippians 4:7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

11. Luke 1:13-14 But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. {14} "And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth.

12. John 16:24 "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

CHAPTER THREE - "ASSURANCE OF VICTORY"

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

5. James 1:13-14 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. {14} But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed.

6. 1 John 2:15-16 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. {16} For all that <is> in the world; the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life; is not of the Father but is of the world.

7. 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

8. 2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard <you> from the evil one.

9. Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

10(1). Matthew 6:9 "In this manner, therefore pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 6:13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

(2). Psalms 119:9 How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word. 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You!

(3). 1 John 5:4-5 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world; our faith. {5} Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

(4). Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

(5). James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

6. Psalms 139:23-24 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; {24} And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

7. Psalms 38:18 For I will declare my iniquity; I will be in anguish over my sin.

8. Proverbs 28:13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

9. Psalms 86:5 For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in mercy to all those who call upon You.

10. Ephesians 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

11. Hebrews 10:12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,

12. Hebrews 10:17 then He adds, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."

13. Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ forgave you.

14. 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
