CHAPTER ONE - THE CHURCH

1. Colossians 1:15-20

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. {16} For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. {17} And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. {18} And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence. {19} For it pleased <the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, {20} and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

2. Colossians 1:19

For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell,

3. Ephesians 1:7

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

4. 1 John 4:7-8

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. {8} He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

5. Romans 12:4-5

For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, {5} so we, <being> many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

If the whole <were> hearing, where <would be> the smelling? {18} But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased. {19} And If they <were> all one member, where <would> the body <be>? {20} But now indeed <there are> many members, yet one body. {21} And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." {22} No, much rather, those members of the body which seem to be weaker are necessary. {23} And those <members> of the body, having given greater modesty, {24} but our presentable <parts> have no need. But God composed the body, having given greater honor to that <part> which lacks it, {25} that there should be no schism in the body, but <that >the members should have the same care for one another. {26} And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with <it>; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with <it> {27} Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.

7. 1 Corinthians 12:26

And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with *<*it*>*; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with *<*it*>*.

8. 1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

And He Himself gave some <to be> apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, {12} for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, {13} till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; {14} that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, {15} but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head; Christ; {16} from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

14. Acts 20:17-38

From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. {18} And when they had come to him, he said to them: "You know, from the first day that I came to Asia, in what manner I always lived among you, {19} "serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and trials which

happened to me by the plotting of the Jews; {20} "how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house, {21} "testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. {22} "And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, {23} "except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. {24} "But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. {25} "And indeed, now I know that you all, among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God, will see my face no more. {26} "Therefore I testify to you this day that I <am> innocent of the blood of all <men>. {27} "For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God. {28} "Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. {29} "For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. {30} "Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves. {31} "Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears. {32} "So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. {33} "I have coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. {34} "Yes, you yourselves know that these hands have provided for my necessities, and for those who were with me. {35} "I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' " {36} And when he had said these things, he knelt down and prayed with them all. {37} Then they all wept freely, and fell on Paul's neck and kissed him, {38} sorrowing most of all for the words which he spoke, that they would see his face no more. And they accompanied him to the ship.

15. 1 Peter 5:2-4

Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; {3} nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock; and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.

16. Hebrews 10:25

not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as <is> the manner of some, but exhorting <one another>, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

And they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." {53} So the father knew that <it was> at the same hour in which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives." And he himself believed, and his whole household.

When He had said these things He cried, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!" {9} Then His disciples asked Him, saying, "What does this parable mean?" {10} And He said, "To you it has been given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God, but to the rest <it is given> in parables, that 'Seeing they may not see, And hearing they may not understand.' {11} "Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. {12} "Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. {13} "But the ones on the rock <are those> who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away. {14} "Now the ones <that> fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity. {15} "But the ones <that> fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep <it> and bear fruit with patience.

"Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

"If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. {11} "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and <that> your joy may be full.

For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.' " {11} Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.

18. Psalms 40:8

CHAPTER FOUR - PRINCIPLES OF PRAYER

Psalms 62:8

Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; God <is> a refuge for us. Selah

2. Hebrews 10:19-22

Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, $\{20\}$ by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, $\{21\}$ and $\langle having \rangle$ a High Priest over the house of God, $\{22\}$ let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

3. Luke 11:1-13

Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, <that> one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples." {2} So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as <it is> in heaven. {3} Give us day by day our daily bread. {4} And forgive us our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one." {5} And He said to them, "Which of you shall have a friend, and go to him at midnight and say to him, 'Friend, lend me three loaves; {6} 'for a friend of mine has come to me on his journey, and I have nothing to set before him'; {7} "and he will answer from within and say, 'Do not trouble me; the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give to you'? {8} "I say to you, though he will not rise and give to him because he is his friend, yet because of his persistence he will rise and give him as many as he needs. {9} "So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. {10} "For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. {11} "If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if <he asks> for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? {12} "Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? {13} "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will <your> heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

4. Philippians 4:6-7

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; {7} and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

5. Psalms 50:15

Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me."

6. John 14:13-14

"And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. $\{14\}$ "If you ask anything in My name, I will do $\langle it \rangle$.

7. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Rejoice always, {17} pray without ceasing, {18} in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

8. Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

14. Matthew 21:22 "And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."

15. 1 John 5:14-15

Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. {15} And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

16. John 15:7

"If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.
