CHAPTER ONE - WHO IS GOD

1. Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

2. Deuteronomy 4:39

"Therefore know this day, and consider <it> in your heart, that the LORD Himself <is> God in heaven above and on the earth beneath; <there is> no other.

3. Deuteronomy 7:9

"Therefore know that the LORD your God, He <is> God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;

4. Deuteronomy 10:17

"For the LORD your God <is> God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe.

5.1 Chronicles 28:9

"As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a loyal heart and with a willing mind; for the LORD searches all hearts and understands all the intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will cast you off forever.

6.1 Chronicles 29:10-13

In Your hand <is> power and might; In Your hand <it is> to make great And to give strength to all. {13} "Now therefore, our God, We thank You And praise Your glorious name.

7. Psalms 46:1

God <is> our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.

8. Psalms 147:3

He heals the brokenhearted And binds up their wounds.

Psalms 147:4

He counts the number of the stars; He calls them all by name.

Psalms 147:5

Great <is> our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding <is> infinite.

Psalms 147:6

The LORD lifts up the humble; He casts the wicked down to the ground.

Psalms 147:1

Praise the LORD! For <it is> good to sing praises to our God; For <it is> pleasant, <and> praise is beautiful.

9. Proverbs 15:3

The eyes of the LORD <are> in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good.

But the LORD <is> the true God; He <is> the living God and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth will tremble, And the nations will not be able to endure His indignation.

'Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You.

15. Malachi 3:6

"For I <am> the LORD, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.

16. Matthew 5:48

"Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect.

17. Mark 12:28-31

Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, "Which is the first commandment of all?" {29} Jesus answered him, "The first of all the commandments <is>: 'Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one. {30} 'And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This <is> the first commandment. {31} "And the second, like <it>, <is> this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

18. John 1:18

No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared <Him>.

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

For <there is> one God and one Mediator between God and men, <the> Man Christ Jesus, {6} who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time,

CHAPTER TWO - THE HOLY SPIRIT

1. Genesis 1:2

The earth was without form, and void; and darkness <was> on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

2. John 3:5-8

Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. {6} "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. {7} "Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' {8} "The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

3. John 14:26

"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

4. John 16:7

"Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.

5. John 16:8-11

"And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: {9} "of sin, because they do not believe in Me; {10} "of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; {11} "of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

6. John 16:13

"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own <authority>, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

7. John 16:14-15

"He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare <it> to you. {15} "All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare <it> to you.

8. Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

9. Acts 13:2-4

As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." {3} Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent <them> away. {4} So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus.

10. Romans 8:6

For to be carnally minded <is> death, but to be spiritually minded <is> life and peace.

11. Romans 8:14-16

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. {15} For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." {16} The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

12. Romans 8:26

Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

13.1 Corinthians 2:12

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

14.1 Corinthians 6:18-19

Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. {19} Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit <who is> in you, whom you have from

God, and you are not your own?

15.1 Corinthians 12:7-11

But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit <of all>: {8} for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, {9} to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, {10} to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another <different> kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. {11} But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

16. Galatians 5:22

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

17. Ephesians 1:13-14

In Him you also <trusted>, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, {14} who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.

18. Ephesians 4:30

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

1 Thessalonians 5:19

Do not quench the Spirit.

CHAPTER THREE - KNOW YOUR ENEMY

1. Genesis 3:1-5

Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" {2} And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; {3} "but of the fruit of the tree which <is> in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.' " {4} Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. {5} "For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

2. Matthew 6:9-13

"In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. {10} Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as <it is> in heaven. {11} Give us this day our daily bread. {12} And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. {13} And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

3. Mark 9:43

"If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed, rather than having two hands, to go to hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched;

Mark 9:47-48

"And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire; {48} "where 'Their worm does not die, And the fire is not quenched.'

4. Luke 8:12

"Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

5. John 8:44

"You are of <your> father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and <does not> stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own <resources>, for he is a liar and the father of it.

6. 2 Corinthians 4:4

whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.

7. Ephesians 6:10-12

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. {11} Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. {12} For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual <hosts> of wickedness in the heavenly <places>.

8. Hebrews 2:14-15

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, {15} and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

9.1 Peter 5:8-9

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. {9} Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

10. Revelation 12:9

So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

11. Revelation 20:10

The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet <are>. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

CHAPTER FOUR - CONFLICT WITH SIN

1. Jeremiah 17:9

"The heart <is> deceitful above all <things>, And desperately wicked; Who can know it?

2. Mark 7:21-23

"For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, {22} "thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. {23} "All these evil things come from within and defile a man."

3. John 3:19-20

"And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. {20} "For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed.

4. Romans 1:18

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

5. Romans 2:8

but to those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness; indignation and wrath,

6. Romans 3:10-12

As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; {11} There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God. {12} They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one."

7. Romans 3:23

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

8.2 Thessalonians 1:8-9

in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. {9} These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

9. James 4:1-3

Where do wars and fights <come> from among you? Do <they> not <come> from your <desires for> pleasure that war in your members? {2} You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and war. Yet you do not have because you do not ask. {3} You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend <it> on your pleasures.

James 4:4

Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

10. James 4:17

Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do <it>, to him it is sin.

11. 1 Peter 2:11

Beloved, I beg <you> as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,

12.1 John 1:8

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

13.1 John 2:16

For all that <is> in the world; the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life; is not of the Father but is of the world.

1 John 2:17

And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

14. Romans 5:1

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

Romans 8:1

<There is> therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

15. 1 John 2:1-2

My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. {2} And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

16. Matthew 5:23-24

"Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, {24} "leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

17. Matthew 18:15

"Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother.

18. Luke 19:5-8

And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house." {6} So he made haste and came down, and received Him joyfully. {7} But when they saw <it>, they all complained, saying, "He has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner." {8} Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold."

19. Hebrews 3:12-13

Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; {13} but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

20. 1 John 5:4-5

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world; our faith. {5} Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

CHAPTER FIVE - THE RETURN OF CHRIST

1. Matthew 16:27

"For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

Matthew 24:27

"For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. Mark 13:26-27

"Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. {27} "And then He will send His angels, and gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest part of earth to the farthest part of heaven.

Luke 12:40

"Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."

2. John 14:2-3

"In My Father's house are many mansions; if <it were> not <so>, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. {3} "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, <there> you may be also.

3. Acts 1:9-11

Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. {10} And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, {11} who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This <same> Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

4.1 Corinthians 4:5

Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God.

5. 2 Corinthians 5:10

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things <done> in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

6. Philippians 3:20-21

For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, {21} who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

7. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. {17} Then we who are alive <and> remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

1 Thessalonians 4:18

Therefore comfort one another with these words.

8.1 Thessalonians 5:1-3

But concerning the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I should write to you. {2} For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. {3} For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.

9.1 Thessalonians 5:4-6

But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief. {5} You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness. {6} Therefore let us not sleep, as others <do>, but let us watch and be sober.

10.1 Timothy 4:1

Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,

2 Timothy 3:1-5

But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: {2} For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, {3} unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, {4} traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, {5} having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

2 Peter 3:3-4

knowing this first: that scoffers will come in the last days, walking according to their own lusts, {4} and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as <they were> from the beginning of creation."

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. {11} Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner <of persons> ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, {12} looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat?

2 Peter 3:13

Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

12. James 5:7-8

Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See <how> the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain. {8} You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.

13.1 John 2:28

And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.

14. Revelation 1:7

Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen.

15. Revelation 22:20

He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen . Even so, come, Lord Jesus!
