## **CHAPTER ONE - HELPING OTHERS FIND CHRIST**

- 1. Matthew 9:10 Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, <that> behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples.
- 2. John 3:16-18 "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. {17} "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. {18} "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- 3. John 5:24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.
- 4. John 6:44 "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 5. John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
- 6. Acts 4:12 "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."
- 7. Acts 20:20 "how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house.
- 8.Philippians 2:14-15 Do all things without complaining and disputing, {15} that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,
- 9. Colossians 4:5-6 Walk in wisdom toward those <who are> outside, redeeming the time. {6} <Let> your speech always <be> with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.
- 10. Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God <is> living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- 11. Proverbs 14:12 There is a way <that seems> right to a man, But its end <is> the way of death.

Mark 8:36-37 "For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? {37} "Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

Romans 1:20 For since the creation of the world His invisible <attributes> are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, <even> His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,

## **CHAPTER TWO - FOLLOW-UP**

- 1. Matthew 10:29-31 "Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will. {30} "But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. {31} "Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.
- 2. 1 Corinthians 4:14-15 I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved children I warn <you>. {15} For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet <you do> not <have> many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel.
- 3. 1 Corinthians 11:1 Imitate me, just as I also <imitate> Christ.
- 4. Colossians 1:9 For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;
- 5. Colossians 1:28 Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
- 6. 1 Thessalonians 2:7-8 But we were gentle among you, just as a nursing <mother> cherishes her own children. {8} So, affectionately longing for you, we were well pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God, but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us.
- 7. 1 Thessalonians 2:10-12 You <are> witnesses, and God <also>, how devoutly and justly and blamelessly we behaved ourselves among you who believe; {11} as you know how we exhorted, and comforted, and charged every one of you, as a father <does> his own children, {12} that you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.
- 8. 1 Thessalonians 2:13 For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed <it> not <as> the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe.
- 9. 1 Thessalonians 3:5 For this reason, when I could no longer endure it, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter had tempted you, and our labor might be in vain.
- 10. 1 Timothy 4:12 Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.
- 11. 1 Timothy 6:11 But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness.
- 12. 2 Timothy 1:3 I thank God, whom I serve with a pure conscience, as <my> forefathers <did>, as without ceasing I remember you in my prayers night and day,
- 13. 2 Timothy 3:10-11 But you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance, {11} persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured. And out of <them> all the Lord delivered me.

#### **CHAPTER THREE - POWER IN PRAYER**

- 1. Psalms 107:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for <He is> good! For His mercy <endures> forever.
- 2. Psalms 113:1 Praise the LORD! Praise, O servants of the LORD, Praise the name of the LORD!:2 Blessed be the name of the LORD From this time forth and forevermore!:3 From the rising of the sun to its going down The Lord's name is to be praised.
- 3. Matthew 7:9-11 "Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? {10} "Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? {11} "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!
- 4. Matthew 18:19 "Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.
- 5. Matthew 26:39 He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You <will>."
- 6.Mark 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.
- 7. Luke 18:1 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,
- 8. Luke 18:9-14 Also He spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: {10} "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. {11} "The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank You that I am not like other men; extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax collector. {12} 'I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess.' {13} "And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise <his> eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!' {14} "I tell you, this man went down to his house justified <rather> than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."
- 9. John 16:24 "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.
- 10. John 17:24 "Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- 11. Acts 12:5 Peter was therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church.
- 12. Acts 16:25 But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them.
- 13. Ephesians 6:18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints;
- 14. Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of <our> lips, giving thanks to His name.

- 15. James 4:3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend <it> on your pleasures.
- 16. 1 Peter 4:7 But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers.

## **CHAPTER FOUR - SCRIPTURAL GIVING**

- 1. - 2. Proverbs 3:9 Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase;
- 3. Matthew 6:2-4 "Therefore, when you do a charitable deed, do not sound a trumpet before you as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory from men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. {3} "But when you do a charitable deed, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, {4} "that your charitable deed may be in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will Himself reward you openly.
- 4. Matthew 6:19-21 "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; {20} "but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. {21} "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- 5. Matthew 6:31-33 "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' {32} "For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. {33} "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- 6. Matthew 19:21-24 Jesus said to him, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." {22} But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions. {23} Then Jesus said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven. {24} "And again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."
- 7. Mark 12:41-44 Now Jesus sat opposite the treasury and saw how the people put money into the treasury. And many <who were> rich put in much. {42} Then one poor widow came and threw in two mites, which make a quadrans. {43} So He called His disciples to <Himself> and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all those who have given to the treasury; {44} "for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood."
- 8. Luke 6:38 "Give , and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."
- 9. Luke 12:15 And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses."

- 10. Luke 12:16-21 Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully. {17} "And he thought within himself, saying, "What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?' {18} "So he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my goods. {19} 'And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, <and> be merry." ' {20} "But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?' {21} "So <is> he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."
- 11. Acts 20:35 "I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'
- 12. 2 Corinthians 8:9 For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.
- 13. 2 Corinthians 9:7 <So let> each one <give> as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.
- 14. Galatians 6:6 Let him who is taught the word share in all good things with him who teaches.
- 15. 1 Timothy 6:9 But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and <into> many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition.
- 16. 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all <kinds of> evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- 17. Hebrews 10:34 for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven.
- 18. Hebrews 13:5 <Let your> conduct <be> without covetousness; <be> content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."
- 19. 1 Peter 4:10 As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

## **CHAPTER FIVE - WORLD VISION**

- 1. Genesis 22:18 "In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

- 10. 2 Corinthians 5:18-20 Now all things <are> of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, {19} that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. {20} Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore <you> on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.
- 11. Revelation 7:9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands,
- 12. Revelation 15:4 Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For <You> alone <are> holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."
