These 2 additional questions, not found in the exam booklet are designed to make the student dig into the Biblical text and show they understand the Biblical principles studied throughout the course.

Questions 1 – Explain the meaning of: “if anyone does sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.” (see 1 John 2.1)

1 - POSSIBLE ANSWERS

An advocate is someone who come alongside another when they are in need. When we confess our sins He comes to restore us to the Father based on His righteous work.

- [1 John 3:10](#) In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is he who does not love his brother.

EXAM 4 – From the Bible text of this lesson, describe several ways in which a believer can best testify to the fact that “the Father sent the Son as the Savior of the world.”

- [Mark 12:29-33](#) The most important law is to love God.
- [1 John 4:14](#) We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world.
- [Rom. 5:5](#) God pours His love into our hearts.
- [John 3:17](#) God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
- [John 8:18](#) I am One who bears witness of Myself, and the Father who sent Me bears witness of Me.

EXAM 5 – In what way has studying 1 John increased your confidence that you do indeed “have the Son”? How has the book challenged you to live for Him?

- [1 John 5:12](#) He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
- [Rom. 12:1-2](#) Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by

the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

- [James 1:21-25](#) Lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.
